

BY-LAWS for the SCOSTEP Scientific Discipline Representatives

Approved by SCOSTEP Bureau on 18 November 2022

- (1) As defined by the SCOSTEP Constitution, SCOSTEP's Scientific Discipline Representatives (hereinafter referred as SDRs) will collectively serve as a source of scientific advice and development of new programs, and projects, and as potential leaders and members of the SCOSTEP Bureau, steering committees and working groups.
- (2) The SDRs shall play active but voluntary roles in SCOSTEP activities.
- (3) The selection of SDR candidates is by nomination by the Bureau. Candidates will be selected from the solar-terrestrial physics community with a consideration of the balance of different disciplines, gender, and geographic distribution. After selection of the SDR candidates by the Bureau, the SDRs are assigned when the candidate accepts the invitation from the Bureau.
- (4) The term of an SDR is four years with an option for an additional four-years upon mutual agreement with the Bureau. The maximum time to serve as an SDR is 8 years in lifetime.
